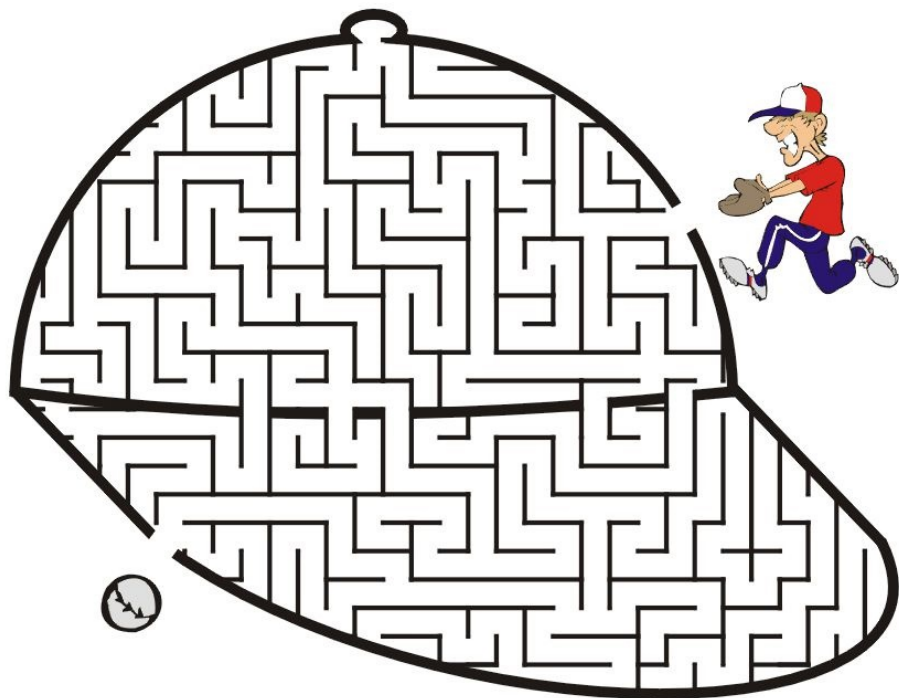

Basic Iced Tea

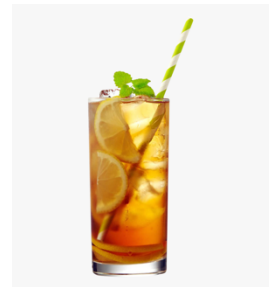
2 ¼ cups water

6 regular size tea bags (Orange Pekoe)

6 cups cold water

In a small saucepan, bring the 2 ¼ cups water to a gentle boil. Add the tea bags, remove the saucepan from the heat, and cover. Steep for 15 min. Remove the tea bags without squeezing them (which would add bitterness) and pour the steeped tea into a 2 ½ quart heatproof container. Add the 6 cups cold water and mix. Let cool at room temperature, then refrigerate until cold. Serve over ice, garnished with lemon wedges and mint springs.

You can add up to 1 ½ cups sugar if you like it quite sweet.



DIY Pizza Bagels

These pizza bagels are way better than any you could get in the store.

What You Need:

Plain bagels (*or thick slices of French bread or English Muffins*)

Tomato/pizza sauce

Mozzarella cheese



Pizza Toppings: pepperoni, ham, peppers, olives, ham, pineapple, goat cheese or any other of your favourite toppings

Directions:

Toast your bagel for a few minutes while you get everything else ready.

Spread tomato/pizza sauce on your bagel and add cheese and toppings.

Microwave for 20-30 seconds to melt the cheese.

(Or bake your bagel with toppings in a preheated oven at 375 ° for 10 minutes or until cheese is melted and slightly browned.)

You are good to go!

Dirt Cups

Celebrate summer with these super easy and delicious dirt cups!

Prep: 10 mins **Total:** 1 hr 15 min **Servings:** 8

What You Need:

2 cups cold milk

1 (4 ounce) package instant chocolate pudding mix

1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed

1 (16 ounce) package chocolate Oreo sandwich cookies, crushed

Gummy worms



Directions:

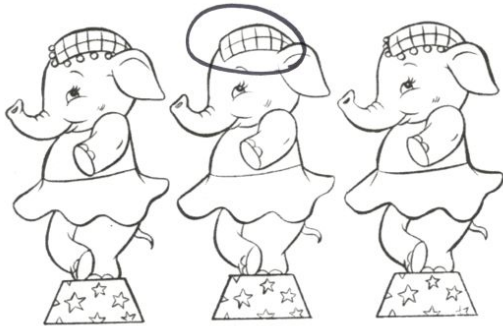
Beat milk and pudding mix together in a bowl until well blended and slightly thickened; let stand to thicken, about 5 minutes.

Stir whipped topping and ½ of the crushed cookies into pudding.

Spoon 1 tablespoon crushed cookies into each serving cup. Fill each cup ¾-full with pudding mixture and top with remaining crushed cookies. Refrigerate for 1 hour.

Top with a gummy worm or two and “dig” in!
